Power Trading Results

In December 2019, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 80.2 TWh. The share of Order Book traded power was 43.0 TWh which includes 1.3 TWh from German Power.

Electricity Certificates Trading Results

In December 2019 the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 2.029 million EI-Certs.

Carbon Trading Results

In December 2019 the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 0.063 million tonnes.
