Power Trading Results

In February 2022, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 44.8 TWh. The share of Order Book traded power was 23.0 TWh which includes 0.5 TWh from German Power.

In February 2022, the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 183 thousand EI-Certs.

Carbon Trading Results

In February 2022, the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 0.011 million tonnes.
