## Power Trading Results in August 2016

In August 2016, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 90.7 TWh (August 2015: 152.2 TWh). The share of Order Book traded power was 52.9 TWh (August 2015: 98.3 TWh) which includes 12.5 TWh from German Power (August 2015: 15.4 TWh).

## Carbon Trading Results in August 2016

In August 2016 the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs and CERs was 0.12 million tonnes as compared to 0.20 million tonnes in August 2015.
