## **Power Trading Results in January 2016**

In January 2016, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 157.5 TWh (January 2015: 112.6 TWh). The share of Order Book traded power was 90.8 TWh (January 2015: 72.8 TWh) which includes 14.9 TWh from German Power. (January 2015: 11.3 TWh).

## **Carbon Trading Results in January 2016**

In January 2016 the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs and CERs was 0.5 million tonnes as compared to 0.3 million tonnes in January 2015.
