Power Trading Results in September 2017

In September 2017, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 127.8 TWh (September 2016: 164.8 TWh). The share of Order Book traded power was 60.7 TWh (September 2016: 96.4 TWh) which includes 13.0 TWh from German Power (September 2016: 18.1 TWh).

Electricity Certificates Trading Results in September 2017

In September 2017 the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 1.54 million El-Certs as compared to 1.15 million El-Certs in September 2016. The share of Order Book traded El-Certs was 0.06 million El-Certs (September 2016: 0.05 million El-Certs).

Carbon Trading Results in September 2017

In September 2017 the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 0.31 million tonnes as compared to 0.44 million tonnes in September 2016.
