Power Trading Results in June 2018

In June 2018, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 105.8 TWh (June 2017: 91,1 TWh). The share of Order Book traded power was 51,7 TWh (June 2017: 46,0 TWh) which includes 11,5 TWh from German Power (June 2017: 8,0 TWh).

Electricity Certificates Trading Results in June 2018

In June 2018 the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 1.67 million El-Certs as compared to 1.35 million El-Certs in June 2017. The share of Order Book traded El-Certs was 0.07 million El-Certs (June 2017: 0.02 million El-Certs).

Carbon Trading Results in June 2018

In June 2018 the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 0.21 million tonnes as compared to 0.02 million tonnes in June 2017.
