Power Trading Results in November 2018

In November 2018, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 77.5 TWh. The share of Order Book traded power was 33.1 TWh which includes 2.9 TWh from German Power.

Electricity Certificates Trading Results in November 2018

In November 2018 the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 1.43 million El-Certs. The share of Order Book traded El-Certs was 0.02 million El-Certs.

Carbon Trading Results in November 2018

In November 2018 the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 0.34 million tonnes.
