Power Trading Results in June 2019

In June 2019, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 58.8 TWh. The share of Order Book traded power was 29.6 TWh which includes 1.0 TWh from German Power.

In June 2019 the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 1.17 million El-Certs.

Carbon Trading Results in June 2019

In June 2019 the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 0.216 million tonnes.
