Power Trading Results in September 2019

In September 2019, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 82.4 TWh. The share of Order Book traded power was 40.7 TWh which includes 2.3 TWh from German Power.

Electricity Certificates Trading Results in September 2019

In September 2019 the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 1.27 million El-Certs.

Carbon Trading Results in September 2019

In September 2019 the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 0.075 million tonnes.
