

# Nasdaq Private Capital – Buyout Global™ Index



The Nasdaq Private Capital - Buyout Global Index (the “Index”) tracks the performance of global buyout markets using the Nasdaq eVestment™ private markets dataset as its starting universe. The Index aims to offer a transparent, diversified benchmark updated quarterly to reflect the evolving market landscape.

- **Transparency:** The index leverages institutional-quality private markets data from Nasdaq eVestment™. Data is sourced directly from Limited Partners to help reduce self-reporting bias and help ensure reliable constituent selection and index construction.
- **Representativeness:** Benchmark with confidence using a broad, globally sourced fund universe filtered by strict eligibility requirements to reflect the true investable landscape across private asset classes.
- **Robustness:** A disciplined methodology produces benchmarks that seek to reflect private capital performance.

## Index Methodology at a Glance

1



### Eligibility

Funds must meet core data requirements (vintage year, NAV, capital calls, distributions, and quarterly reporting) to ensure consistent, reliable inputs.

### Filter the Funds

To remove outliers, the top 2.5% and bottom 2.5% of funds in the buyout universe are excluded.

### Calculate Returns

Fund performance is measured using a money-weighted return approach that reflects actual investor cash flows.




### NAV Weighting

Each fund's return is weighted by its beginning-of-quarter NAV so larger funds have a proportionate impact on the index.
