

Nasdaq Sustainable Bond Network (NSBN) DATA USAGE AND DISTRIBUTION POLICY

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NASDAQ GLOBAL DATA AGREEMENT, ALL DISTRIBUTORS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH THE NASDAQ REQUIREMENTS WHICH INCLUDES THE NASDAQ SUSTAINABLE BOND NETWORK (NSBN) DATA USAGE AND DISTRIBUTION POLICY DETAILED HEREIN. UNASDAQ MAY UPDATE THESE POLICIES PERIODICALLY, AND SUCH UPDATES WILL BE COMMUNICATED VIA [NASDAQ DATA NEWS](#).

1. Overview.

The Nasdaq Sustainable Bond Network (NSBN) Data Usage and Distribution Policy (the “**NSBN Policy**”) governs the processes, usage, and distribution rights for Information made available through the Nasdaq Sustainable Bond Network. This policy is supplemental to the [Nasdaq Global Data Agreement \(GDA\)](#).

2. Information Usage.

- The Information is provided for Distributor’s internal informational purposes only.
- Notwithstanding the above, Distributor shall have the limited right to use limited amounts of the Information for inclusion in reports and analytical material regarding Distributor’s investments into sustainable bonds on a non-continuous basis for either external or internal, as long as Distributor provides proper attribution to Nasdaq.
- In using the Information, Customers acknowledge and agree that they may be subject to and must comply with any additional third-party terms and conditions. All such terms and conditions applicable to the Information are located [here](#).

3. Information Restrictions.

- Distributor shall not use, reproduce, duplicate, copy, sell, trade, resell or exploit the Information for any commercial purpose.
- Without limiting the above, Distributor shall not use any Nasdaq Sustainable Bond Information, in whole or in part, to create an index, custom or otherwise, unless separately licensed by Nasdaq.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of the Global Data Agreement, Distributor may not distribute the Information to Affiliates without prior written consent of Nasdaq.
